### NOTES FROM FR. VANDEWALLE

**St. Vitus' Soup Dinner!** Yes, already next weekend (Sunday, February 10<sup>th</sup>)! Many Thanks to all who have put in such work and sacrifice this year and in past years! Working together for a good common cause, especially for the cause of God's family, is a wonderful thing, and hopefully even some fun. I suggest we all offer a decade of the Rosary, the Second Luminous mystery for the success of this year's Soup Dinner! This mystery reminds us of Mary's concern for those at the wedding Feast in Cana, particularly the married couple, but I think we can extend it to consider our care of all who attend, and that it can mirror Mary's.

**World Marriage Day** is the Second Sunday of February. **History** - The idea of celebrating marriage began in Baton Rouge, LA in 1981, when couples encouraged the Mayor, the Governor and the Bishop to proclaim St. Valentine's Day as "We Believe in Marriage Day". The event was so successful; the idea was presented to and was adopted by Worldwide Marriage Encounter's National Leadership. By 1982, 43 Governors officially proclaimed the day and celebrations spread to U.S. military bases in several foreign countries. In 1983, the name was changed to "**World Marriage Day**", designated to be celebrated each year on the second Sunday in February. In 1993, his Holiness, Pope John Paul II, imparted his Apostolic Blessings on **World Marriage Day**.
