

NOTES FROM FR. VANDEWALLE

Adoration—Sunday, March 25th, 4:00pm (moved from the regular 5:00pm) at St. John's with Evening Prayer during communal penance

Stations of the Cross will be held on Good Friday, March 30th, at Noon at St. John's.

NO 5:30 pm Mass on Holy Saturday; The Easter Vigil begins at 8:30 pm.

Saunders Catholic Schools invite you to attend a follow up Open Forum on April 3rd at 7:00pm at the Bishop Neumann Cafe'. This Open Forum, and others in the future, will give more detail about the financial needs of the schools as we work toward a more balanced funding model for the Catholic schools in Saunders County. All are invited, please join us.

Holy Thursday Adoration — Sign-up Sheet is in the back of St John's Church from 8:00pm to midnight. It would be great to have 3 or more people sign up for each half-hour slot. After the Holy Thursday Liturgy, we remember Our Lord in the Garden of Olives and in prison before his passion. Mother Teresa taught us that Jesus loves it when we "draw close."

What is The "Triduum"?— The Triduum is the "Three" days leading into Easter (1) Holy Thursday recalls the Last Supper at which Jesus instituted the Holy Mass, the Priesthood and washed the Apostles' feet; afterwards we process to the adoration chapel of the convent where there will be adoration until midnight. (2) Good Friday recalls the Passion of the Lord and we venerate the cross. (3) Holy Saturday, we wait with Jesus in the tomb during the day and begin the Easter Vigil at dusk (8:30 pm) with the Easter Fire and new Easter Candle.

Try something new? - At The Chrism Mass the three oils used in the Sacraments are blessed for the whole diocese; the Cathedral is packed; the sanctuary is filled with about 140 priests; a resounding organ, choir and congregation sings praises. It is this Monday, March 26th, 5:00+pm at the Cathedral in Lincoln. Arrive early for seating.

The Good Friday collection is for the Holy Land. Your support allows the Franciscans to conduct parish ministry, provide Catholic education, feed the hungry, build houses for Christians, maintain shrines and operate refugee centers in the Holy Land.

The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday. Jesus asked St. Faustina and us to pray the Chaplet on nine consecutive days for the special intentions he gave her: they should be in the back of church by mid-week.

Small point of pronunciation - Not a big deal, but during the reading of the passion, when the crowd says "Prophesy!" I think it is pronounced "Prof – ih – sigh" rather than "Prof-ih-sEE". And a word that I said wrong for about two or three years, "grievous" in the Confiteor is pronounced "GrEEv-uhs" rather than "GrEEv-EE-us."
